## Description of the Papers

Hard copies of local newspapers to document how the events were covered in Maine. Remembrance ribbon, presumably produced during USM's 2002 Remembrance events.

Gathered newspapers from 9/11 to the following Sunday.

Weird runs: The Portland Press Herald produced a second edition on September 11<sup>th</sup> (special edition) to cover the events that occurred that morning. The Sun Journal incorrectly dated their 9/15/01 paper as 9/14/01. Note that the Sun Journal's cover story for 9/14/01 is "A terrible moment." The Sun Journal's cover story for 9/15/01 is "A nation takes time to mourn."
