 I'll need them in the end.*

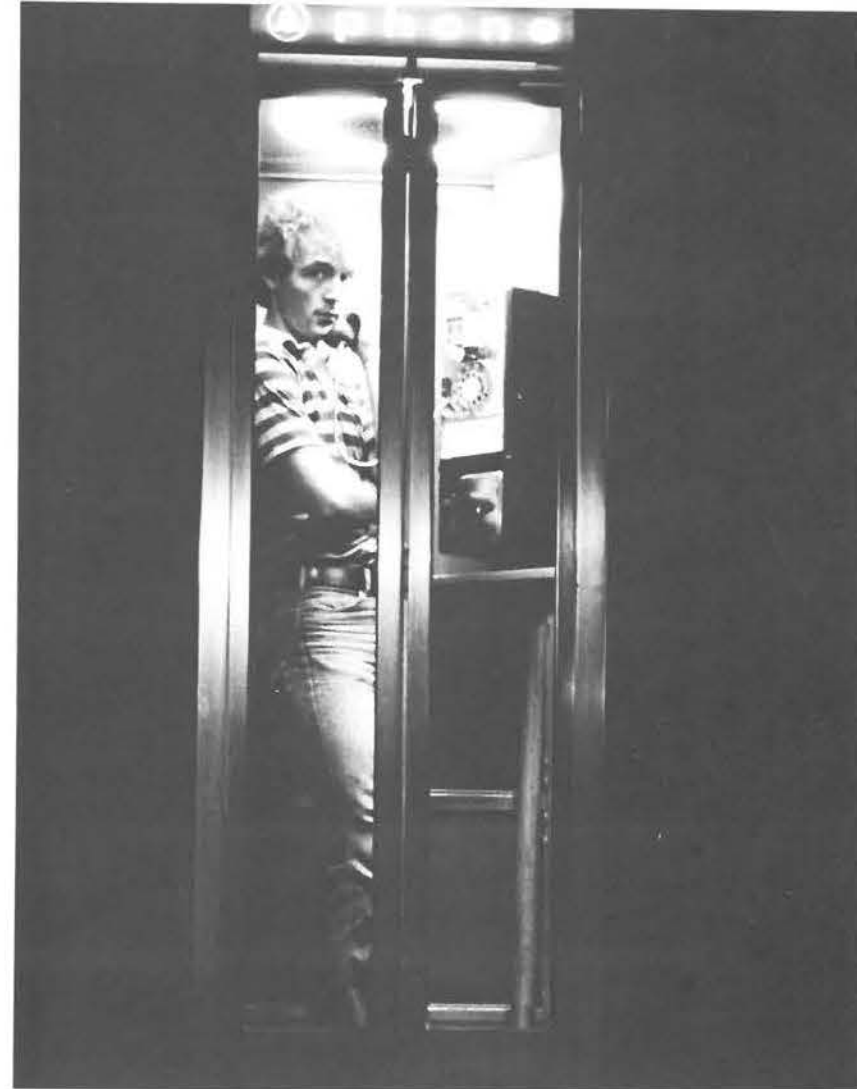
