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PORTLAND JUNIOR COLLEGE ARCHIVES GEN MS 50

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Historical Note

The Portland Junior College, or the PJC, opened in 1933 as a non-profit educational institute in response to the inaccessibility of typical 4-year colleges to families impoverished by the Great Depression. It was of the interest of a group of businessmen, one of which who was the future dean of the college, Luther I. Bonney, to provide advanced education to qualified high school graduates who were otherwise unable to seek college training, whether it be by virtue of location or financial status. In conjunction with the Portland Young Men's Christian Association, a plan to offer inexpensive college courses in Portland was formed. The YMCA's facilities were to be utilized for classrooms.

Finding funding and greater support from the four pre-existing Maine colleges proved immensely difficult. However, Everett W. Lord, founder and dean of Boston College's College of Business Administration, was willing to help. Lord would provide a program that the Junior College could base theirs on, send teachers down every week to assist in teaching classes, and accept full credit transfers into his programs. The first semester in 1933 saw only 60-70 students enrolled, but it was considered a great success.

With the beginning of U.S. involvement in World War II, the student body would shrink down to only fourteen by the 1943 spring semester. In June of the same year, it was decided that scholastic activities were to be suspended for the duration, with the college re-opening for regular courses officially in September of 1946.

By 1945, it became clear that veterans would seek college education post-war, but many of them had not completed high school or lacked the basic courses needed for admission to colleges. In cooperation with the Veterans Administration in Maine and the State Department of Education, and encouragement from the Maine colleges, a program of intensive college preparatory courses was developed. Put into operation by the college in January of 1946, the initial enrollment of 70 veterans would grow to 250 in number by the summer. This pre-college program would be in continuous operation—

summer included—until June of 1949, and served over a thousand veterans during the nearly three years that it was running.

1946 saw the college becoming too big for its britches, so to speak. It was decided that the College—at the time housed in two separate buildings in Portland—had need of a permanent campus. Six acres of the historical Deering Estate were purchased, and the pre-existing buildings renovated and restored. Resources were regrettably limited, with the necessary furniture and materials having to be obtained cheaply. However, the PJC would not formally move to the new campus and start holding classes there until 1948. This same campus is the one where the modern day University of Southern Maine at Portland resides, albeit with some newer buildings.

The Portland Junior College would merge with the University of Maine system in 1957, to become the University of Maine at Portland.

Description of the Collection

This collection contains material pertaining to the Portland Junior college dating from 1933-1958. Included are administrative and financial records, various pieces of memorabilia (diplomas, newspapers, physical objects, etc), minutes, interviews, photographs, programs and brochures, and publications. Items of particular note per series include two large bound books containing the financial and account records of the PJC in series 1, a collection of PJC-related pennants and banners in series 2, physical books of minutes from series 3, two tapes recordings of interviews in series 4, original photographs in series 5, various letters and a dance card with a miniature pencil in series 6, and a large quantity of catalogs and brochures in series 7, plus four published works.

This collection has been divided into 8 series. The groupings are as followed:

Series 1: Records

Subseries 1: General Files

This series (dates ranging from 1933-1957) includes materials such as the following: information regarding the background of the school, the purchase of the Deering estate, student rosters, curriculum information, faculty lists, class lists, various administrative papers, posters and flyers, and correspondence between Luther Bonney and the Dean Lord. Materials one could consult If wishing to know more about the founding of the school include the documents PJC Background and Organization (1945 Jan, undated) and Summary – Facts about PJC (1941 Sep).

Subseries 2: Financial Records

This series (dates ranging from 1933-1957) includes materials such as overall finance records, account books, delinquent accounts, correspondence regarding delinquent accounts, student new charges, invoices, checks, receipts, disbursements, treasurer's reports, auditor's reports, with-holding tax records, and vouchers. Items of note include two large bound books containing the financial records and account records of the Portland Junior College. See oversize for these materials.

Series 2: Memorabilia

Subseries 1: Certificates & Diplomas

This series contains student graduation diplomas and a certificate from the Portland Junior College to Arthur Doggett.

Subseries 2: Newspaper Clippings & Related Papers

This series includes a number of newspaper clippings from a variety of Maine newspapers, with dates ranging from 1936-1952. One outlier is dated at 1994. The subjects pertain to the students, faculty, curriculum, and alumni/students lost in WWII and the Korean War. A message log from one C. Ferrante at the Normandy Coast is included in this subseries. A radio traffic report for the information net dated at 1994 is also included.

Subseries 3: Objects

This series includes a number of physical objects related to the PJC, with dates varying from 1941-1957, with some undated. Items of note include the pen/quill used to sign the L. D. 1408 Resolve in favor of Portland Junior College being Chapter of the Resolves of 1951, a box addressed to Richard Hoyes containing two pins, three green & white PJC banners, and two green & white PJC pennants. A watercolor painting attributed to an L. Foster, full name unknown, has a list of 1941-1945 World War II honor roll students' names inked on it. There is also an early draft of the PJC's seal, by Frederick Wheelock. Yearbook dedications dating 1948-1957 can also be found here.

Series 3: Minutes

In this series is a collection of minutes dated from 1933-1957. These include minutes from the Board of Directors, students, faculty, and student & faculty clubs.

Series 4: Interviews

This series is a collection of interviews regarding Luther Bonney and the PJC, plus an autobiography by Andrew J McSween, PJC class of 1939. There is one group interview dated to Febuary 1965 held between Luther Bonney, Harry W. Rowe, Mrs. Elizabeth Eastman, George S. Jackson, Harold M. Lawrence, Raymond S. Oakes, and Philip Towle. There are two solo interviews between Luther Bonney & a Miss Duval, dated June and August of 1974 respectively. All three of the interviews concern the history of the PJC. There are two physical cassette tapes included, and written transcripts of all 3. McSween's autobiography is titled *Angel on My Shoulder: The Life Story of Andrew J. McSween*. The text is complete.

Series 5: Photographs

This series is a collection of photographs of Portland Junior College students, faculty, and members of the business administration. Included is a photo of the first student body at PJC in 1933, and photos of the graduating classes of 1938, 1938, 1940, 1941, 1949, 1950, 1951, 1952, and 1957. Also included is a photo of Frank R. Stein and his family with the alumni award of 1955.

Series 6: Programs

Subseries 1: Programs – Commencement & Convocation

This subseries includes programs of events, speeches, invitations, and letters regarding the commencements and convocations held at the Portland Junior College. They are dated from 1948-1957, with some documents undated. Most letters and invitations retain their original envelopes.

Subseries 2: Programs – Dramatics Club & Other Special Events

This subseries includes programs for various special events held by the Portland Junior College, including plays performed by the dramatics club(s) and social dances. The dates on these materials range from 1939 to 1957. Items of note include the script for a play written by a PJC student, and two dance cards. One of the dance cards has a miniature pencil attached.

Series 7: Publications

Subseries 1: Brochures

This subseries includes brochures related to and/or advertisement of the Portland Junior College. The dates range from 1938-1953.

Subseries 2: Catalogs & Bulletins

This subseries includes catalogs for Portland Junior College courses dated 1933-1956, and bulletins of various titles dated 1947-1950, and 1957-1958.

Subseries 3: Directories

This subseries contains student & faculty directories and an administrative bulletin index. Two small portable directories in book format are included. The directories are dated 1947-1948, with one sheet of paper undated. The administrative bulletin index is also undated.

Subseries 4: Published Material

This subseries contains four published works dated from 1933-1955. These include publications and histories of the Portland Junior College (1933-1943) by Luther Bonney, A History of Portland Junior College (1933-1948) by Margaret E. Wilbur, The Story of Portland Junior College (reprint from Pine Cone) 1953, and History of This Site (1955) by Richard J. Kilbride.

Series 8: Oversize

This series is a combined grouping of the oversized materials within the collection from individual series.
