Article 1.

The name of this association shall be "The Hebrew Ladies' Society".

Article 11.

Object: To promote the interests of the Beth Israel Synagogue of Bath, Maine, and to further the spiritual life in the community.

Article 111.

Membership: By joining the association, all members automatically become active.

Article 1V.

Officers & their Election: The officers of this Society shall be a

president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer, and four trustees.

All officers shall be chosen by a nominating committee, appointed by the president in May of each year, and elected the following month for the term of one year.

the president.
