to be a Notary Public within and for each and every of our Counties through the State, for and during the term of Seven Years if he shall so long behave himself well in said office.

And we do hereby authorize the said

LOUIS PHILIPPE GAGNE

to execute and perform all the powers and duties which appertain to said Office, enjoining him in all respects to conform to the Laws regulating the same.

May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-four

and in the one hundred and sixty-eighth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
