BY LAWS

Article I.

The name of this association shall be "The Hebrew Ladies' Society".

Article II.

Object: To promote the interests of the Beth Israel Synagogue of Bath, Maine, and to further the spiritual life in the community.

Article III.

Membership: By joining the association, all members automatically become active.

Article IV.

Officers & their Election: The officers of this Society shall be a president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer, and four trustees.

All officers shall be chosen by a nominating committee, appointed by the president in May of each year, and elected the following month for the term of one year.

A vacancy occurring during the year shall be filled by appointment of the president.

The duties of the officers shall be such as are implied by their respective titles.

Article V.

Meetings: The meetings during the months from October through June shall be held every other Sunday evening at a member's house. During the months of July, August and September, meetings shall be held at the Synagogue the first Tuesday of each month.

Special meetings may be called at any time at the discretion of the president. *or trustees*

Seven members shall constitute a quorum at any regular, special or at the annual meeting.

Article VI.

Amendments: Amendments may be adopted at any meeting by a two thirds vote of all members present.

Article VII.

Dues: The dues shall be ten cents per week *\$6 per year paid as desired.* ~~with seven cents extra each meeting for cards and special fund.~~

~~All money in the treasury shall be spent on synagogue.~~

Article VIII.

Standing Committees: There shall be three standing committees- namely, Kitchen, Flower, Visiting.

Responsibilities: Kitchen Committee:- shall be responsible for keeping the kitchen strictly kosher, according to laws and regulations laid down by the forefathers of Ancient Israel.

Flower Committee shall be responsible for all remembrances as occasion requires to any member or members who are confined (not counting common cold) either at home or hospital *(a week or more at home)*

Visiting Committee shall have as its duty the calling on a prospective member or an indisposed member.
