Dear Miss Giguere:

Title I of the Higher Education Act of 1965 sponsors the presentation of educational programs by institutions of higher education here in Maine. The University of Maine has been assigned the responsibility by the Governor for administering this program with the advice and assistance of an Advisory Council.

In consultation with Governor Curtis it was decided that you would make a real contribution to the work of the Council. Would you be willing to accept an appointment to the Council for a three year term, July 1, 1968 through June 30, 1971? All Council members are eligible for reappointment.

While there is no remuneration for this assignment, all traveling expenses are covered. The Council meets three or four times a year at various locations.

I do hope you will find it possible to accept since I know you will enjoy the work and make a real contribution to the development of meaningful community service programs.
