## Biographical Note

Kenneth T. H. Brooks (1916-1995) served as President of Gorham State Teacher's College, 1960-68, then continued as President of the University of Maine at Gorham, 1968-70, but stepped down when Gorham was merged with the University of Maine at Portland.

This small, miscellaneous group of papers focuses on Brooks in his role as head of the Gorham teaching institution from 1921-1971. The Chronological file contains honors he received from other academic institutions as well as several of his grade and high school papers.
