Our social functions are always highlights during the year in youth activities. We hold several dances each year culminating with our annual spring formal "Basin Street".

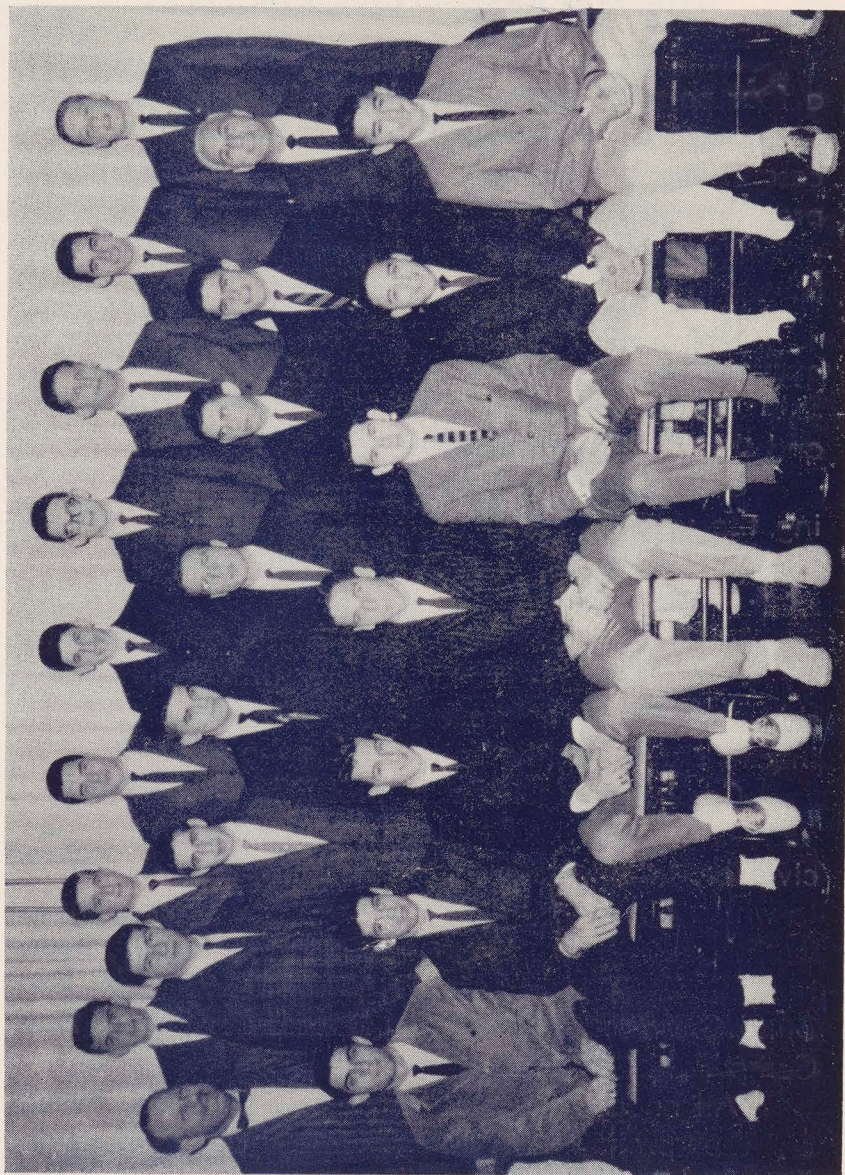
We participate in many athletic contests with other fraternities in the city. At all times sportsmanship and fine play are encouraged. These contests inspire much healthy spirit within the Club.
