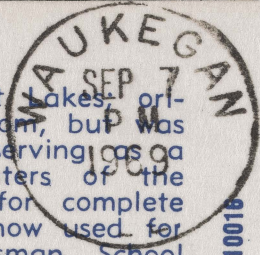






**ALL SOULS CHAPEL**

One of the oldest buildings at Great Lakes, originally built as an ordinance stockroom, but was converted into a chapel in 1919, serving as a Naval hospital chapel. The Daughters of the American Republic provided funds for complete remodeling in 1946. The Chapel is now used for Sunday worship for Hospital Corpsman School students. Plans are under way to replace all windows with stained glass as a memorial for all doctors and hospital corpsmen who have given their lives in the service of their country.
