A ANDROSCOGGIN COUNTY *A Center of French - American People*

- ① - Nearly 40 per cent of the population of the county brought up in French speaking homes.
- ② - A higher percentage than any other New England County
- ③ - Largest French Mother Tongue Population of any county in Maine (9th in New England)* (67 counties in all)
- ④ - one quarter of the French Mother Tongue Population of Maine lives in Androscoggin county
- ⑤ - Well over half of the French Population of Maine lives in Androscoggin and ~~bordering~~ bordering counties. (56.6%)

B Lewiston

- ① - one of three New England cities with the largest number of French Mother Tongue persons. (Manchester, Woonsocket)
- ② - one of four New England cities with more than half of the population with French Mother Tongue (Berlin, Woonsocket, Biddeford)
- ③ - shows strength of cultural heritage
87% native-born americans
