

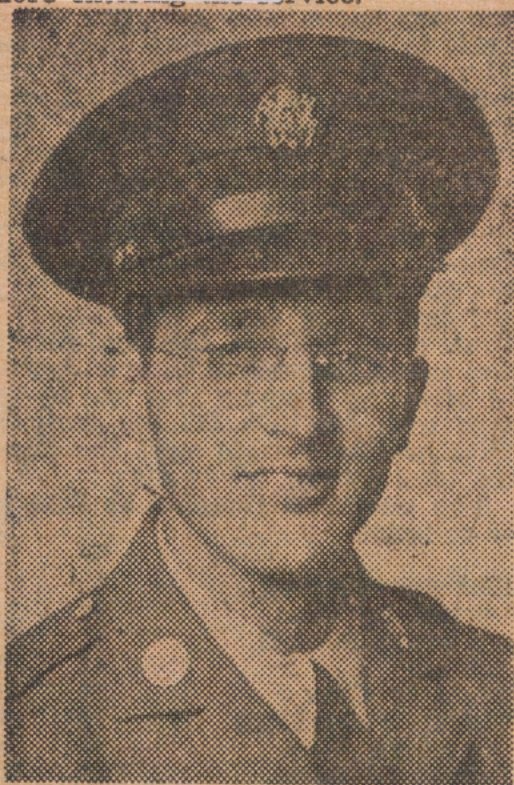

PFC ELISEE DUTIL, 71 River Street, Lewiston, recently attended the Immaculate Conception services held in Strasbourg. This marked the first time in more than four years that worship services had been held in this famed Cathedral. More than 2,000 American soldiers, of whom 1,200 were Third Infantry Division men, presented a congregation so large that the Division Chaplain, assisted by regimental chaplains was forced to deliver his sermon from two different places in order that he might be heard by all.
