#### **BIOGRAPHY:**

Adelard Tarcisius Janelle (1889-1984) was born in Greene, Maine. At the age of 7, his family moved to Lewiston. At 16, he became a member of the ASSOCIATION ST DOMINIQUE, which had been founded by his father, William Janelle. At 18, he became a member of the UNION ST JEAN-BAPTISTE's Lewiston chapter (*Conseil 159*), of which he was president from 1913-1916 and a board member from 1907-1946. He was also involved with other Franco organizations. Janelle played an important role in fundraising for the BASILICA OF SS. PETER AND PAUL and was known as the unofficial 'city historian' for many years. In 1981, he was honored by the CENTRE D'HERITAGE for his efforts.

#### **SCOPE AND CONTENTS:**

In addition to biographical and career information on Adelard Janelle, there are photographs and documents from the extended Janelle-Paradis family and their homes, especially the Janelle family of JANELLE'S DEPARTMENT STORE and the Paradis family of PARADIS-LEBLANC CLOTHING STORE and Henry N. Paradis, mayor of Lewiston.
