He was born in Lewiston, attended St. Peter's School and is a graduate of Lewiston High School.

Before his induction he worked at the Bates Mfg Co. and was very active in the Defenseurs, the Cadets of the Catholic Order of Foresters. He was a charter member of the Dionne Post VFW, and was also a member of the St. Peter and Paul Parish Choir.

He was inducted into the service in June 1942 and was sent overseas in January 1943. He landed in England where he was temporarily stationed; then participated in the invasion and campaigns of North Africa, Sicily, Italy, and was wounded in the battle of Anzio. He later fought in France where he was wounded a second time, and then went to Germany where he was fatally wounded March 18, 1945. PFC. Dutil was awarded the Purple Heart with Cluster.

He is survived by his father, two
