The following business was transacted:

2. It was decided that the savings account would be replaced with a checking account.
3. It was suggested that the Treasurer should ~~xxxx~~ give the Secretary a monthly accounting of expenses for his records.
4. Sturgis Haskins was elected Secretary Pro Tem. Karen Bye appointed a Nominating Committee to consider a new Secretary. After a brief caucus David Perkins and John Frank were chosen as nominees. The Secretary Pro Tem, in accordance with the By-laws will mail out notices of an election in two weeks.
5. The Wednesday, December 26 meeting was cancelled.
6. The Treasurer reported \$60.74 in the Treasury.
7. Bob Majer reported on his visit to a Toronto gay group. He enjoyed himself very much.
8. Sturgis Haskins reported on the following:
  - a. He had talked with a Banger News person about them printing a low-key article on the group.
  - b. Someone in Hancock County had expressed interest in reviving that group as a purely social organization.
  - c. The Unitarian Church Sunday discussion group rap for the past two Sundays had gone extremely well.
  - d. The cost of mailing the announcements out had been about \$6.00
  - e. He had put an ad in the Maine Times as GSA had voted some time ago.
9. The meeting adjourned to an informal discussion on various matters.
