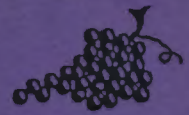

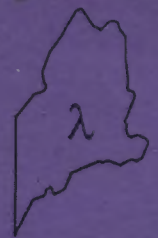

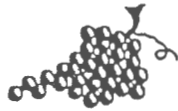
SEE YOU JUNE 20TH!

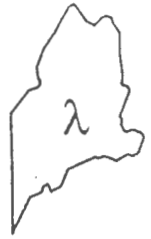

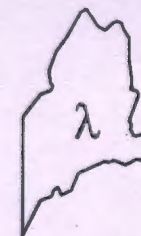

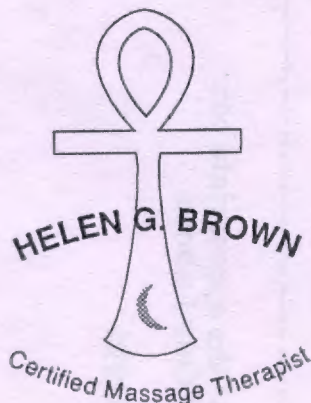
