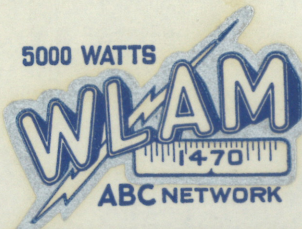

Dear Mr. Gagne:

Our construction work has been completed and we hope to put W L A M on the air sometime this month. The engineers from Washington are now making proof-of-performance tests. After they have completed their work we have to wait for the FCC to give us final permission to go on the air. This makes it impossible for us to set in advance a definite time for our opening.

However, we are making plans for a rather modest one-half hour dedicatory program the first day we go on the air. I wish that it might be possible for you to take part in this program and broadcast a brief message.

We plan to have the program in our own studios at 129 Lisbon St. and plan to have only six prominent persons from the State and our community speak approximately from three to five minutes each.

I hope it will be convenient for you to take part in this program. When I have official word from Washington as to the date that we can go on the air, I will communicate with you again.
