General Meeting Notes:

A. Reports

1-Newsletter - The newsletter is now being run off on our new copier at the Susan B. Anthony Club (SBA). There is presently no set deadline for the newsletter (NL) due to volunteer's free time schedule. Policy for subscriptions needs to be set. There will be a NL workshop at the next MLF meeting run by Cathy to resolve the issue.

An Open Letter to All MLF -- Nov. 12, 1979

Dear MLF Sisters,
Once again I feel a need to express and make clear to the readers of the MLF Newsletter what should have been printed in the last Newsletter instead of what was, under;
"Minutes from Oct. 20, meeting-3 Sec. B"

"There is a police harrassment problem in Portland--police are watching drunk sisters the hardest so we need to help keep these Q out of their view. Encourage drunk or fighting lesbians to stay off the streets".

What should have been reported:
"There is a police harrassment problem in Portland, as there is everywhere, to lesbian Q and Q in general. The police are apt to focus upon a lesbian Q leaving the bar area, or in the bar area (and/or a lesbian couple) in public view.

It was felt and agreed by the Q at the general meeting that if this being the case, it is our responsibility to help aid our sisters and whenever possible to help prevent any such thing fromhappening to our sister(s) in the first place. Several Q agreed (if not all) that we should not turn our backs upon our sisters.

THE MAINE NUCLEAR REFERENDUM NEEDS YOUR HELP!

A group of men and Q here in Maine are involved in gathering 37,500 valid signatures in order to put the nuclear power question on referendum for next year's ballot. This is a very specific and direct process in which we can appeal to the Maine residents in a non-threatening way, for at this point they're not forced to take a stand for or against nuclear power. We're giving them a choice whether they want to have it in our state or not. We've been active since our July 4 March from Wiscasset to Augusta and our deadline on the signatures is late February. We are pushing hard at this point to get people involved during this last vital stretch. After February when we make our quota, we will be turning to educational

measures in order that come November, 1980, people will be informed enough of the hazards and economical disadvantages of nuclear power to vote it down. We have a difficult time ahead of us. 
