Mon. 7-10 am, Irish and eclectic music with Sharon; Mon. 4-6 pm Sweet Temptation (folk) with Stephanie Philbrick; Tues. 1-4 pm, Textures (world music and folk) with Katherine Rhoda; Tues 10 pm-1 am, Blues with Win; Wed. 10 am-12, "Lost Highway" with Peter Twitchell (bluegrass and Western); Thurs. 10 pm-1 am, "Hip Shake" with Mad Dog (blues); Fri. 7-10 am, Blues with Todd; Sat. 9-11 am, Cambodian; 11-12, Afghanistan; 1-2 pm, Latinos; 2-3 pm, British Humor; 3-4 pm, Afropop; Sunday 1 am - 12:30, New Age with Deborah; 12:30-3 pm, "Women's Music and Comedy Festival" with Judy Lynch; 5-7 pm "Summer Sound," folk and swing with Maude; 7-8 pm, "Hear My Train A-Coming," blues with Sherwood.
