Secretary's Report of Annual Meeting

April 14, 1948

Annual meeting of the Lewiston Auburn Tuberculosis Association was held at the Grace Lutheran Church, April 14, 1948. Dr. Karl S. Woodcock presided at the business meeting which followed the dinner.

On motion it was voted to dispense with the minutes of the last annual meeting. Moved and seconded to accept the annual treasurer's report as read. Auditor's report was presented by Mr. George W. Tufts.

Report on Nursing activities read by Dr. R. J. Wiseman revealed a case load of 417. Mrs. Merrill S. F. Greene stated that all media for education were used throughout the year. Special attempt has been made to encourage more participation among school personnel. Mrs. Kaitz spoke on volunteers contributing to our radio program, "Healthy Listening Time". Mass X-ray service report presented by Dr. R. A. Beliveau, chairman shows 907 x-rays were taken of students, school personnel and Bates College freshmen class.

In the executive secretary's annual report a summary of the year's work was presented. In reviewing the finances an increase of \$ 840. in the 1947 Christmas Seal Sale over last year's Seal Sale was revealed. In closing the executive secretary questioned our present program. "Just how we can best serve the tuberculous, his family and community during the coming year? Does our present program satisfactorily meet the problems of today? Are we making effective use of the existing facilities?"

In his message President Woodcock pointed out that the program of the Association is the definite responsibility of its members. Appreciation for all who have helped in our program was voiced. The president also brought our attention to the problem regarding the association's headquarters.

Upon the suggestion of Mr. Payne, Mr. William T. Davis accepted the chairmanship for the 1948 Christmas Seal Sale.

Upon the suggestion of Dr. R. J. Wiseman a rising vote of thanks was given to Dr. Woodcock, retiring president.
