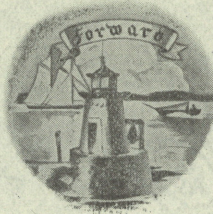


The employees of the City of South Portland have requested a 30 percent increase over their present salaries. They have quoted your City as paying higher wages and salaries.
