My dear Mr. Mayor:

Your letter of April 29th just received in the mail, and I am pleased to receive the appointment to serve as a member of the Special Civic Committee to study and make recommendations to amend the present Sunday "Blue" Laws, and to make them more liberal.

It may interest you to know that I was duly installed as the Legislative Officer of the Normand Dionne Post # 2299, Veterans of Foreign Wars, on April 2, 1948. This is a new office that has been created within the Post this past year. I was Adjutant last year, having been installed in April 1947.
