CLOSING ANNOUNCEMENT

GUY: I'm sorry gentlemen, but apparently our time is up, and I have a very important announcement which will be of great interest to the proponents of a zoning ordinance in Lewiston. Only a few short hours ago, I was advised by Mayor Gagne that the zoning ordinance, as drafted by the zoning committee of which Attorney Delehanty was chairman, and as amended, was scheduled to have its first reading at tonight's meeting of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen. In other words, unless there are unsuspected developments, the zoning ordinance will probably become law in Lewiston before the month of June. The Lewiston Chamber of Commerce is indeed happy to have the privilege of making this announcement since it has always advocated its passage, and a battle of some twenty five years duration comes to a happy conclusion. We have only words of praise for Mayor Gagne and to the incoming Board of Aldermen for taking up the matter so promptly after coming into office. I wish to thank Attorney Delehanty and Mr. Palangi for being with us tonight and discussing the zoning question.

And now, just a word about next week's program. Insofar as the week of April 20th has been designated as Clean Up Week in Maine, we will deviate somewhat from the type of program we have been presenting.

At that time we will explain to you the plans of the Chamber of Commerce to assure the success of this campaign in our community, and representatives of the fire department, the health department and the public works department will explain what you can do during that week to help make our city cleaner, healthier and more beautiful. We invite your comments on this broadcast and invite you to be with us again next week at this same time. Until then, goodnight, and here is your announcer.
