I heard from Neil Clark - he is in the Ellis Islands - he still has to receive about 3 letters I sent him - his moving has caused the delay. How long is it taking my mail from #708 to reach you? How many letters have been censured by the boss? Has anything been deleted? I wrote to Aunt Ida this afternoon - tonight Dad and I will go to a concert in records if it does not rain. Sunday goes out ~~tomorrow~~ tomorrow - finally! I have plenty of underwear fortunately! I still need nothing - ^{do} I understand that you need a winter request and will send me if I study anything I can't get here.

In line with my meditation program I have

worked out a black map of Europe - each country
in a different color - and with black blocks to be
pinned over the country as Germany takes it; in this
way, the conquests of the Nazis will be graphically
and easily shown. I got my first little talk on
Wednesday night. The whole program is good for me
since it keeps up the office routine.

Not much news as you can see - oh, yes -
I am getting the Bulletin very regularly too.
I'll add a line before I mail this in the morning.
