

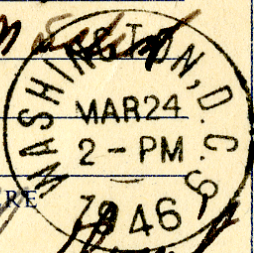
24 March 1946
