Dear Ones-

I added a line to my note this morning - but I'll repeat it: please thank Uncle Herb for his letter to me - I did not include him in my letter to Aunt Etta. Also in writing to Boston thank Aunt Amy & Judy for their loyalty & regularity in correspondence.

Boy - it's a good thing I have a social secretary on the home front, n'est-ce pas? I heard from Neil Clark - he is in the Ellice islands - he still has to receive about 3 letters I sent him - his moving has caused the delay. How long is it taking my mail from #708 to reach you? How many letters have been censured by the base? Has anything been deleted? I wrote to Aunt Ida this afternoon - tonight Herb and I will go to a concert on records if it does not rain [*sic*] Laundry goes out [*illegible deletion*] tomorrow - finally! I have plenty of underwear fortunately! I still need nothing - I do understand that you need a written request and will send one if I strike anything I can't get here.

In line with my orientation program I have

worked out a block map of Europe - each country in a different color - and with black blocks to be penned over the country as German takes it; in this way, the conquests of the Nazis will be graphically and easily shown. I give my first little talk on Wednesday night. The whole program is good for me since it breaks up the office routine.

Not much news as you can see - oh, yes -

I am getting the Bulletin very regularly, too.

I'll add a line before I mail this in the morning.

It did rain and I went to bed early - nothing special this morning.
