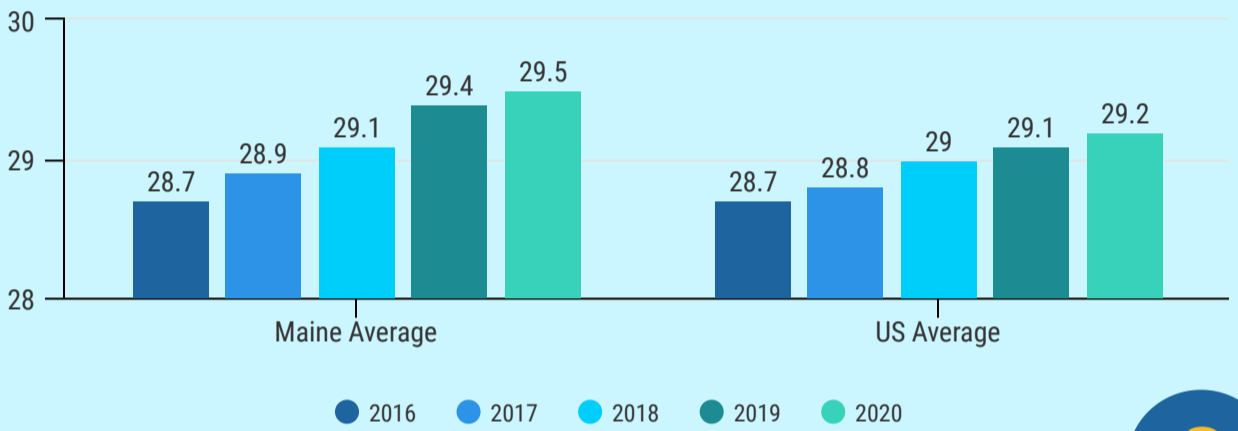

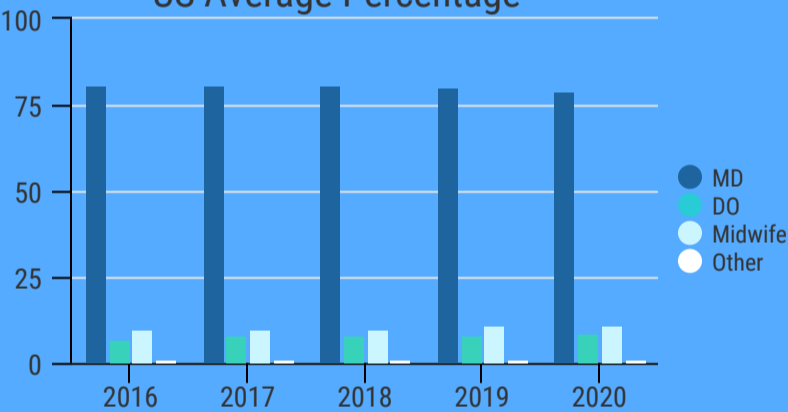

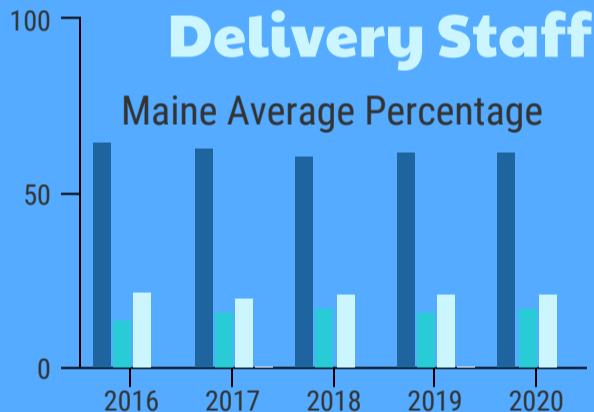

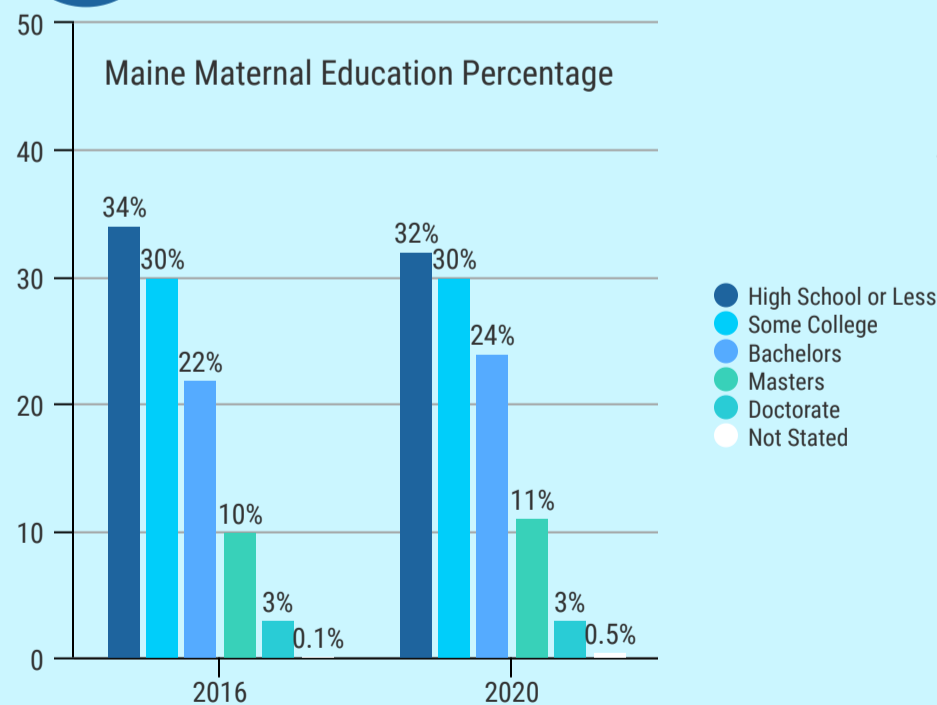
Maine Average Percentage



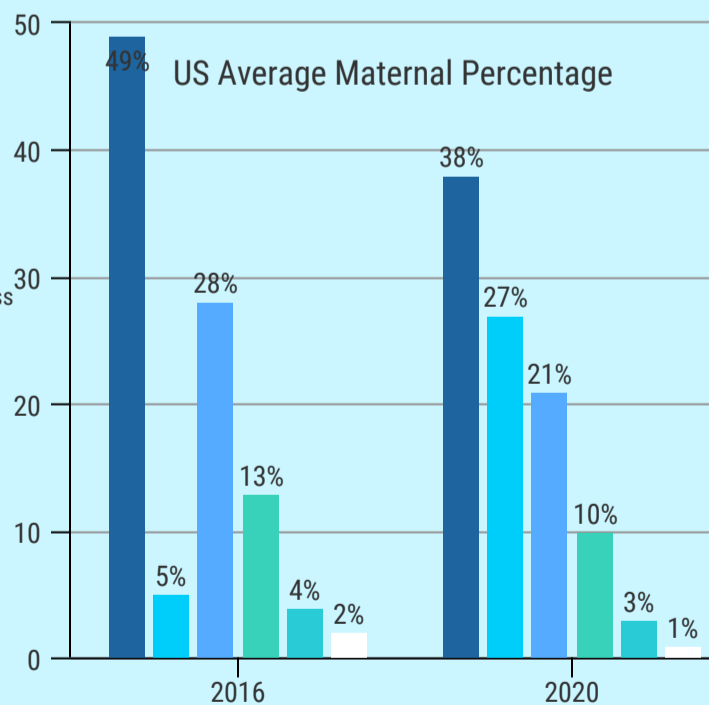

Throughout Maine and the US, between 97-98% of women give birth in a hospital



Birthing clinics are becoming more popular in Maine, rising from 0.1% to 2% from 2016-2020

For the average US place of birth though, birthing clinics take between 0.5-0.6% of births from 2016-2020

Maine and the US has consistently stayed between 1-2% of births in residential areas



Less than 1% of all recorded births have an unlisted place of birth
