The archives includes records of the group, their political task force, and their communications committee, as well as event ephemera from the third Maine Gay Symposium in 1976.

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## Administrative History

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Maine Lesbian Feminist was a social and political group based in Downeast Maine which operated from 1976 to about 1984. According to an oral history interview with founding member Ellie Sparks, they formed at the third Maine Gay Symposium. The group met periodically in various towns and cities across the state, at both private homes and public buildings, often on college campuses. The group published a newsletter, first out of Bar Harbor and later out of Belfast. They formed a political task force in 1977. Maine Lesbian Feminist continued operating until about 1984.

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## Scope and Contents

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Includes records of the group, their political task force, and their communications committee, as well as event ephemera from the third Maine Gay Symposium in 1976.
