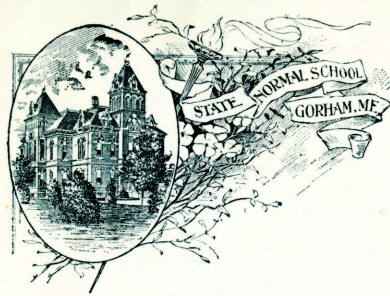


have Miss White, the head

Nov. 20th 1898

Dear Mamma:-

It is a beautiful
day and we can see the ocean
gleaming in the sun.

I think you must have misunder-
stood what I said in my letter
about my board. I did not mean
that you need not send the
money unless you wanted to
but that you could do as you pleased
about sending enough to pay
up to Christmas or up to Thanksgiving.

I shall have to pay up until
Thanksgiving before I come
home anyway. All board
bills have got to be paid before
Thanksgiving. It is \$21.82 up to
Christmas but I don't know

exactly how much it is up to
Thanksgiving but about \$16.11.
I know that the first amount
is right but you had better
recount the last one again if
you don't want to pay up
to Christmas. The time is
fourteen weeks and five days
from Sept. 6 until the Christmas
vacation and I have taken
out the Thanksgiving vacation
which is five days. I have paid
eight weeks and you know.
I don't know as it is clear
to you now but I hope so.

The girls want to go to walk
so I will leave this letter
for a while.

We had a lovely walk. We
went as far as where Henry
Sweetser lives which is about
a mile out of the village. The
mud flows hard and it
is quite cold.

I am glad the exhibition

went off well. I don't think
I ever heard any of the prices.
We have heard that there
is to be a change in the
trains on the M.C. R.R. and
if there is we cannot make
connections at noon and
the girls who live in Camden
would not get home until
Thursday noon. I think
from what Mr. Corthell
has said that if we cannot
make connections at noon
he will let us go Tuesday
night. So you will see
we either Tuesday night
or Wednesday noon.
Probably Wednesday noon.
I am going to write Grace
a little letter so that she
will get it her birthday. I
have now answered her
yet. I seem queer to
