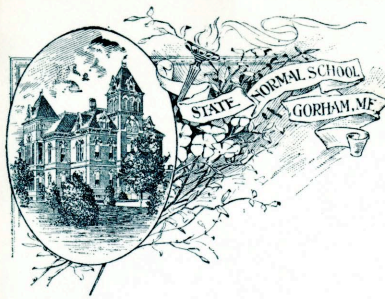


them during study hours.
