ACADEMIC COSTUME

Academic costume originated in Europe over six hundred years ago. It consists of the gown, hood, and cap. Now much modified, each level of academic achievement still retains a distinctive gown and hood.

The academic hoods are lined with the official color or colors of the institution conferring the degree. Gorham State College hoods are lined in green and white.

The edging of the hood varies in width according to the degree. Its color is distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains as follows:
