This 9th-yearly conference will be hosted by the Wilde-Stein Club of the University of Maine at Orono, and will take place in the spring of 1982 in Bangor. Planning sessions will be in the Bangor area. Several NLN members will be attending the first planning session on Saturday, November 21. ▼ Our OCTOBER MEETING featured a guest speaker from ACAP Venus Clinic (Aroostook County Action Program's Sexually Transmitted Disease - STD - program). She gave a truly interesting and informative one-hour presentation about the myriad of specifically gay-related health problems. Bibliothèque Lambda has on file a variety of informational brochures and news articles, made available by the Venus Clinic -- which are ALL recommended reading ("gay cancer", herpes, crabs, hepatitis, VD,...)

▼ NLN's NOVEMBER MEETING will also have a guest speaker. Carolyn Turney from Fredericton has raised her children in an open, non-judgemental atmosphere. She will discuss her experiences as a mother not afraid to expose her children to the realities of life, which include lesbians and gaymen. A pot luck meal (see below) will follow the discussion which will follow our business meeting. The November meeting is on Sunday, 29 November, at 1PM U.S. time (2PM New Brunswick time). 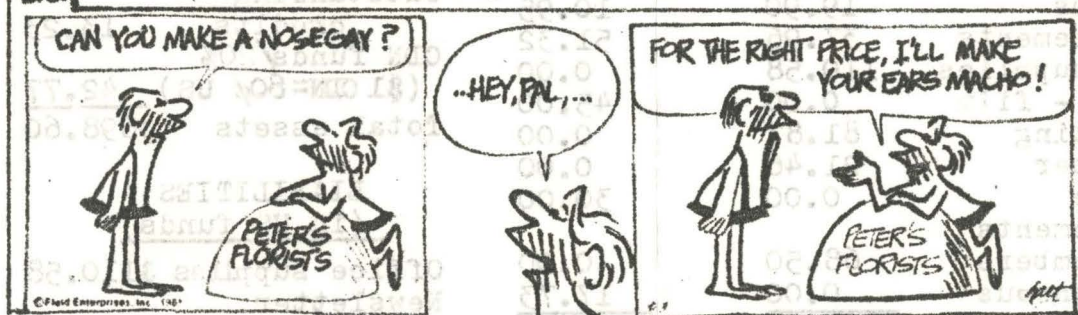
